CONFERENCE REPORT

6th National Conference of the Indian Association of Forensic Odontology

The 6th National Conference of the Indian Association of Forensic Odontology (IAFO) was organised in S.D.M. College of Dental Sciences & Hospital, Dharwad, Karnataka, on 4–5 October 2008. The conference drew a great response with more than 300 registered delegates from all over India.

Prof. C. Bhasker Rao, Principal, S.D.M. College of Dental Sciences & Hospital, Dharwad, welcomed the gathering and enlightened the delegates on the current tends in forensic dentistry and its application in day-to-day practice. He also drew attention to the inclusion of forensic odontology in the revised B.D.S. curriculum. Hon. Mr. Justice K. Sreedhar Rao (Judge, High Court of Karnataka) was Chief Guest of the function and stressed on the importance of formulating a definite protocol which, once legislated, will enable the subject to obtain legal status.
